

We were able to impact the lives of 66 students this year


In our endeavor to reach out to as many students in the spectrum, in line with our vision...

Introduction of pre-primary level

- *This is the first step for early intervention (EI) training.*
- Research has shown that early intervention can improve a child's overall development. Children who receive autismappropriate education and support at key developmental stages are more likely to gain essential social skills and react better in society.
- Introduction of club activities
 - Students across age group split into 8 clubs based on their interest.
 - activity based learning
 - *improves cognition, behavior, coordination, understanding concepts & exposes them to a hobby.*
 - Students progress tracked through monthly reports.
